Pre-exposure prophylaxis (or PrEP) is a way to prevent people who do not have HIV from getting HIV, by taking one pill every day as prescribed.

The Ready, Set, PrEP program
makes PrEP medications available
at no cost for people who qualify.

HOW CAN I ENROLL IN THE READY, SET, PrEP PROGRAM?

To receive PrEP medication
through the Ready, Set, PrEP
program, you must:

- ✓ Test negative for HIV
- ✓ Have a valid prescription from your healthcare provider
- ✓ Not have insurance that covers prescription drugs
